We often marvel at some congregations of the Lord's Church and wonder how they are so strong for the Lord and in His work. Well, maybe this story from **McGuffey Readers**, used in American schools in the 19th and 20th centuries can help us get an idea. The application is powerful...

A man had seven sons who were always quarreling. They left their studies and work to quarrel among themselves. Some bad men were looking forward to death of the son's father, to cheat them out of their property by making them quarrel about it. One day, the father called his sons around him. He laid before them seven sticks, which were bound together. He said to his sons, "I will pay a hundred dollars to the one who can break this bundle."

Each one strained every nerve to break the bundle. After a long but vain trial, they all said that it could not be done.

"And yet, my boys," said the father, "nothing is easier to do." He then untied the bundle, and broke the sticks, one by one, with perfect ease.

"Ah!" said his sons, "it is easy enough to do it so; anybody could do it that way."

Their father replied, "As it is with sticks, so is it with you, my sons. So long as you hold fast together and aid each other, you will prosper, and none can injure you, but if the bond of union be broken, it will happen to you just as it has to these sticks, which lie here broken on the ground."



Brethren this story illustrates for us what makes a strong family, strong congregation, strong organization, in fact anything that wants to endure... Believe it or not, the formula comes from the pages of God's Word, that McGuffey and others borrowed;

"Though one may be overpowered by another, two can withstand him. And a threefold cord is not quickly broken" (Ecclesiastes 4:12).
