Purposes of the Old Testament to Christians

Brethren, here are some reasons why the Lord's church needs to teach the principal purposes of the Old Testament.

- 1. The examples of those who lived under the law were written for our learning (**Romans 15:4; I Corinthians 10:11**).*
- 2. They "testify" to the Deity of Christ (**John 1:45; Luke 24:44; Acts 10:43; Hebrews 6:20; Hebrews 7:15-28; Hebrews 8:1**).*
- 3. They help us understand principles of righteousness (**Hebrews 11:1-12:2**); faith and obedience of Abraham (**James 2:21-24**); patience of Job (**James 5:11**); courage of Elijah (**I Kings 18: 1-40**); moral purity of Joseph (**Genesis 39: 7-12**); and the consequences of Saul's disobedience (**I Samuel 15:13-23**).*
- 4. The Jewish covenant of the Old Testament served the purpose of making the Jews to "know" sin (**Romans 7:7; Galatians 3:19**) and of bringing them "to Christ" (**Galatians 3:23-25**).*
- 5. The law foreshadowed many New Testament institutions (**I Corinthians 5:7; Hebrews 9:1-14; I Peter 2:5-10**).*
- 6. Christ lived under the dispensation of the law of Moses (**Matthew 5:17-19**).*
- 7. In His death, as the one perfect offering for sin, He fulfilled the law and "took it out of the way, nailing it to the cross" (**Colossians 2:14; Ephesians 2:14-16**).*

Conclusion:

*We also need to remember the example of the prophets in the Old Testament as they suffered (**James 5:10**). If we remain "faithful" to the Lord (**Revelation 2:10**) we can "rejoice, and be exceeding glad" for our reward in heaven will be "great" (**Matthew 5:12**). God Holy Book, both Old and New Testaments pave our way to Heaven and help to clear all the obstacles that could potentially keep us from our destination—Heaven! So, "study to show thyself approved" (**II Timothy 2:15**) so that we will be able to "be ready to give an answer" (**I Peter 3:15**).*
